

To Whom it May Concern:

Hi. I have actually just filed a lawsuit on behalf of Mr. Steven Greene- Greene v. City of New York 24-cv-08963. There, my client, Mr. Greene was videotaping several officers in the Bronx who were conducting what appeared to be an unlawful stop and frisk of several young black men in a BMW. One of the officers, Defendant Reale, slaps Mr. Greene's phone out of his hand. BUT what is MOST IMPORTANT for your purposes is that the BWC was not turned on for the officer during the stop. Obviously, the reason I know that, is because I requested the BWC, and it starts after the stop of the BMW, when officers- who I actually think may have been sergeant/s, come up to my client.

I think that is odd and I saw how you BWC footage had been analyzed, according to the report I just skimmed. If such is the case, then you are missing the stops. This has to be on purpose. I will report back as I get more evidence in discovery.
